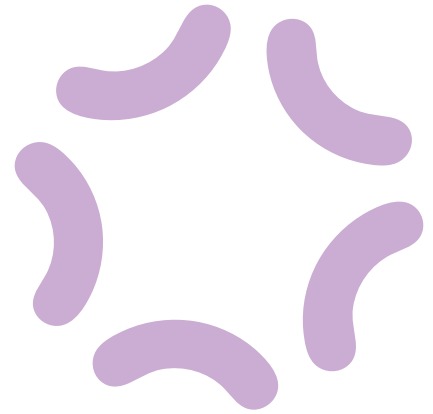
About us
